Runnymede Vest

SIZE

Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Back Width Between Armholes: 14½
(16, 17½, 19¼, 20¾, 22¼)''

*To fit approx. bust meas 34 (38, 42, 46,
50, 54)''*

MATERIALS

Rozetti Yarns Alpaculence (76% acrylic,
9% wool, 9% alpaca, 6% glitter;
100g/536 yds)

- 106 Aquamarine – 3 (3, 3, 4, 4,
4) balls

Needles: US Size 4 (3.5 mm) 40'' circular
or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch
markers,

GAUGE

23 sts x 34 rows = 4'' in Zig Zag Rib patt,
unblocked

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

This easy to wear vest shines in self-shading Alpaculence. The Zig Zag Rib pattern is fun to knit, but easy enough to memorize after a couple of repeats. To maintain the ridgy-ribbed look of the stitch pattern, do not stretch the vest too much during blocking.

STITCH GUIDE

Zig Zag Rib

(multiple of 9 sts + 4)

Row 1 (RS): K1, p3, * k2tog, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, p4; rep from * to last 9 sts, k2tog, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, p3, k1.

Row 2 (WS): P1, k3, p5, * k4, p5; rep from * to last 4 sts, k3, p1.

Row 3: K1, p2, * k2tog, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, p4; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 4: P1, * k4, p5; rep from * to last 3 sts, k2, p1.

Row 5: K1, p1, * k2tog, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, p4; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Row 6: P1, k1, * k4, p5; rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, p1.

Row 7: K1, p3, * yo, ssk, k1, yo, ssk, p4; rep from * to last 9 sts, yo, ssk, k1, yo, ssk, p3, k1.

Row 8: P1, k3, p5, * k4, p5; rep from * to last 4 sts, k3, p1.

Row 9: K1, p4, * yo, ssk, k1, yo, ssk, p4; rep from * to last 8 sts, yo, ssk, k1, yo, ssk, p2, k1.

Row 10: P1, k2, p5, * k4, p5; rep from * to last 5 sts, k4, p1.

Row 11: K1, p5, * yo, ssk, k1, yo, ssk, p4; rep from * to last 7 sts, yo, ssk, k1, yo, ssk, p1, k1.

Row 12: P1, k1, p5, * k4, p5; rep from * to last 6 sts, k5, p1.

Rep Rows 1-12 for patt.

VEST

Cast on 283 (292, 319, 328, 355, 364) sts.

Collar

Work in Zig-Zag Rib patt until piece meas 7½" from cast-on edge, ending with WS row.

Separate for Armholes

Note: To make the color transition smoothly as shown in the sample, begin in the same place of the shading sequence in each ball of yarn.

Row 1 (RS): Work in patt across 100 (100, 109, 109, 118, 118) Left Front sts, attach new ball of yarn and work in patt across 83 (92, 101, 110, 119, 128) Back sts, attach new ball of yarn and work in patt across 100 (100, 109, 109, 118, 118) Right Front sts. Working all sections at once, work even until pieces meas 3½ (4, 4½, 5, 5¼, 5½)" from separation, ending with WS row.

Shape Sides

Note: Read through entire following section before proceeding. Sections will be rejoined before shaping is complete.

Dec row (RS): Working on Left Front piece: K1, p2tog, work in patt to end of Left Front, work in patt over Back, work in patt to last 3 sts of Right Front, p2tog, k1 – 2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec row every other RS row, 14 (14, 5, 5, 0, 0) times, then rep Dec row every RS row, 57 (57, 75, 75, 90, 90) times.

At the same time, when pieces meas 6¾ (7¼, 7¾, 8¼, 8½, 8¾)" , join to work as one piece again, ending after a WS row. Break yarn from Right Front and Back pieces, use yarn from Left Front piece to work across all sts over the next RS row. After all decs are complete, 139 (148, 157, 166, 175, 184) sts rem.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block lightly to finished measurements.

Edging

Row 1 (RS): K139 (148, 157, 166, 175, 184), pm, pick up and knit 138 (138, 143, 143, 151, 151) sts along shaped Right Front edge, pm, 63 (65, 69, 71, 73, 75) sts along upper Right Front, pm, 283 (292, 319, 328, 355, 364) sts along cast-on edge, pm, 63 (65, 69, 71, 73, 75) sts along Upper Left Front, pm, and 138 (138, 143, 143, 151, 151) sts along shaped Left Front edge, turn.

Row 2 (WS): * K1, m1, knit to 1 st before m, m1, k1, sl m; rep from * 4 more times, knit to last st, m1, k1 – 12 sts inc'd, turn.

Row 3: Knit.

Rows 4-7: Rep Rows 2-3, 2 times. Bind off all sts kwise over the next WS row. Sew sides of edging together.

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Armhole Edging

Pick up and knit 78 (84, 90, 96, 98, 100) sts evenly around armhole opening. Knit 6 rows. Bind off all sts kwise over the next WS row.

Abbreviations

approx

dec('d) decrease(d)

inc('d) increased

k knit

k2tog knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)

kwise knitwise

m marker

m1 insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)

meas measures

patt pattern

p purl

pm place marker

p2tog purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

rem remain(ing)

rep repeat

RS right side

sl slip

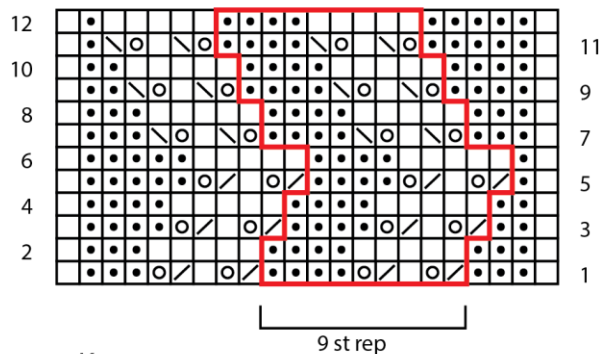
ssk slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)

st(s) stitch(es)

WS wrong side

yo yarn over

Zig Zag Rib

◻ pattern repeat

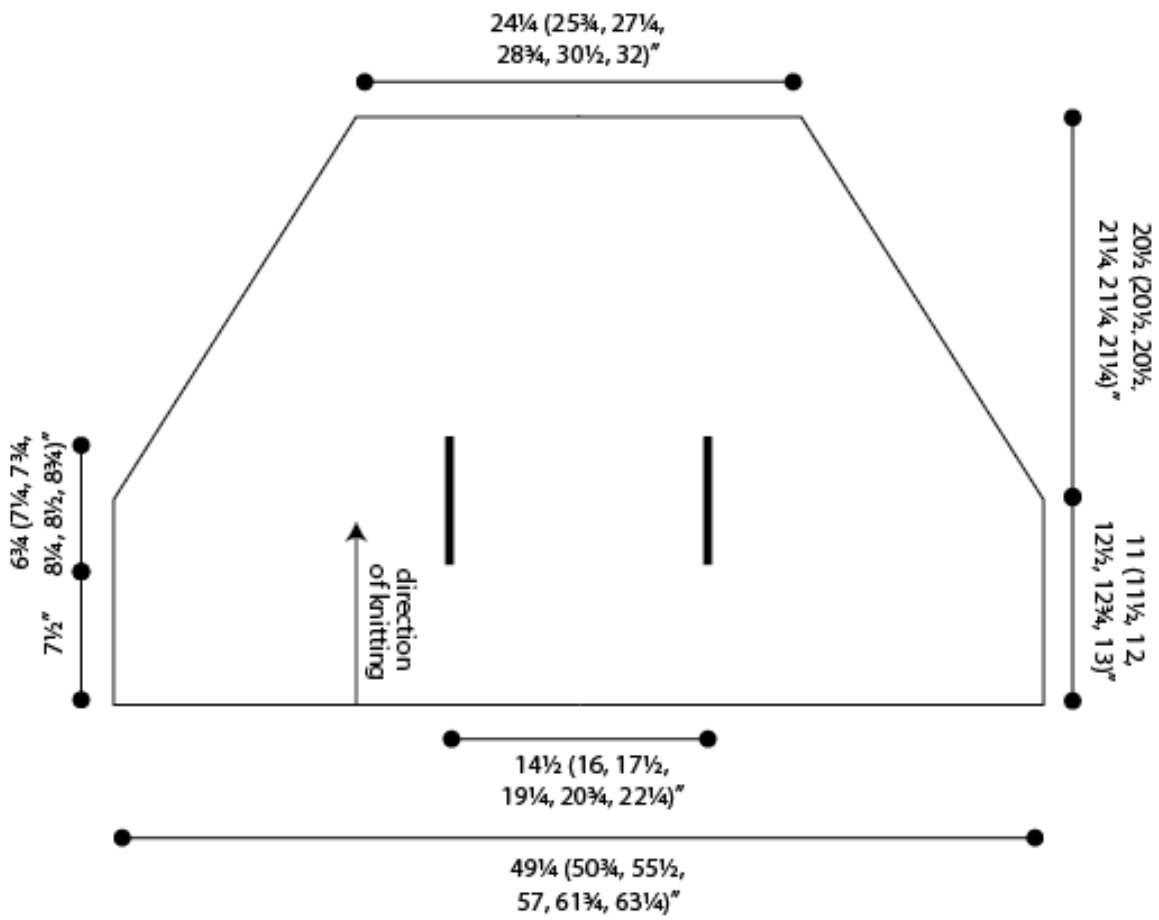
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
