**Skill level:** Easy One size

# finished measurements

Approximately 17" around x 31/4" wide

#### Yarn

1 ball BERROCO COTOLANA (50 grs), #3524 Cypress

# needles and notions

Straight knitting needles, size 8 (5.00 mm) or size to obtain gauge Cable needle (cn) Waste yarn for provisional cast-on Tapestry needle

# gauge

26 sts and 27 rows = 4" in Pat St TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK **GAUGE**

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**NOTE:** We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this book are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical errors.

All pattern PDFs are updated when corrections are made. In the event of finding an error, please make sure you've downloaded the most recent version.

### **NOTE**

Sts for this headband were cast on using a Provisional Cast-on. After working, the ends were joined using Kitchener St. For ease, if you prefer, just cast on in your usual way and sew the ends together.

# **HEADBAND**

Using Provisional Cast-on, cast on 21 sts.

Pattern Stitch: Row 1 (RS): K1, \* k1tbl, k1, rep from \* across

**Row 2 (WS):** K1, \* p1, k1, rep from \* across.

**Row 3 (RS):** K1, \* sl 2 sts to cn and hold in FRONT, k1tbl, sl 2nd st from cn to LH needle and knit this st, sl remaining st to LH needle and knit this st tbl, k1, rep from \* across.

Row 4: Rep Row 2.

Rows 5 – 8: Rep Rows 1 and 2 twice.

**Row 9:** Rep Row 3. **Row 10:** Rep Row 2.

Rep these 10 rows until headband measures 17" (or desired length) from beg, end with Row 3.

# **FINISHING**

Unravel Provisional Cast-on, slipping sts to straight needle. Join ends using tapestry needle and Kitchener St. **Note:** If you used a regular cast-on, bind off sts and sew cast-on and bound-off edges together. Weave in all ends and block as desired.



### **ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS**

**beg:** beginning **cn:** cable needle

k: knit

k1tbl: knit 1 through the back loop

**LH:** left hand **p:** purl

pat(s): pattern(s)
rep: repeat
RS: right side

sl: slip

**st(s):** stitch(es)

tbl: through back loop(s)

WS: wrong side
