29" (or longer) circular needle,
size 10½ (6.50 mm) or size to

PATTERN STITCH

(Odd number of sts)

Row 1 (WS): Knit.

Row 2: K1, * yo, SSK, rep from * across.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: * SSK, yo, rep from * to last st, k1.

Rep these 4 rows for Pattern St.

SCARF

Cast on 41 sts. Work Row 1 of Pattern St. Continuing to work in Pattern St, cast on 8 sts at beginning of every row using Cable Cast-on. Each time you cast on sts, work these sts into Pattern St. Work until yarn is almost gone, end on WS. Bind off loosely knitwise.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.



ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

k: knit

rep: repeat

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

WS: wrong side

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.
