



MANOS DEL URUGUAY

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SIZE

78" long x 9" wide

MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay FINO (70% superfine merino, 30% silk; approx. 100g/490 yds), 1 sk MC plus 1 Miniskein Set. Shown in 425 Fascinator (MC) with kit 6 Flora (423 Tincture [CC1], 407 Velvet Pincushion [CC2], 408 Crystal Goblet [CC3], 404 Watered Silk [CC4], 433 Folly [CC5]).

US4/3.5mm ndl, 24-32" circular, or size to obtain gauge

Stitch marker

Tapestry needle

GAUGE

20 sts and 23.5 rows = 4" over Brioche Stripe pattern

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg: beginning

BO: bind off

Brk: (brioche knit) knit together the next st and its yo

Brp: (brioche purl) purl together the next st and its yo

CC: contrast color

CO: cast on

K: knit

MC: main color

Ndl: needle

P: purl

Patt: pattern

Rep: repeat

Rnd(s): round(s)

RS: right side

Sl: slip

Slyrn: (slip, yarn round ndl) slip the next st purlwise, bring yarn up and around ndl then between the ndls to the front of the work to form yo

St(s): stitch(es)

WS: wrong side

Wyib: with yarn in back

Wyif: with yarn in front

Yfslyo: (yarn forward, slip, yo) bring yarn to the front between the needles, slip the next st purlwise, bring yarn over ndl to back of work to form yo

Yo: yarnover



NOTES

This scarf is worked flat (i.e. back and forth in rows), but a circular needle is required to work the Brioche Stripe pattern.

Slip all sts purlwise.

STITCH GUIDE

Brioche Stripe (odd number of sts)

Row 1A (RS): With A, sll wyib; *yfslyo, brk; rep from * to last 2 sts, yfslyo, k1. Slide sts to other end of ndl.

Row 1B (RS): With B, sll wyib; *brp, slyrn; rep from * to last 2 sts, brp, sll wyib. Turn work.

Row 2A: With A, sll wyif; *slyrn, brp; rep from * to last 2 sts, slyrn, p1. Slide sts to other end of ndl.

Row 2B: With B, sll wyif; *brk, yfslyo; rep from * to last 2 sts, brk, sll wyif. Turn work.

Rep rows 1A through 2B for Brioche Stripe.

INSTRUCTIONS

With MC, CO 45 sts.

Set-up Rows

Set-up Row 1 (RS): With MC, sll wyib; *yfslyo, k1; rep to end of row. Slide sts to other end of ndl and join CCI.

Set-up Row 2 (RS): With CCI, sll wyif; *brp, slyrn; rep from * to last 2 sts, brp, sll wyif. Place locking st marker to show RS of fabric, then turn work.

Section 1

Work in Brioche Stripe patt, beginning with Row 2A, using MC for A and CCI for B. Work rows 2A and 2B, then work 15 complete reps of pattern, thus ending having just worked row 2B. (There should be 32 MC knit sts in each column on the RS, and 32 CC knit sts in each column on the WS.)

Rows 33-62: Work in Brioche Stripe patt, using CCI for A and MC for B. There should be 30 CCI knit sts in each column on the RS, and 30 MC knit sts in each column on the WS.



Rows 63-94: Work in Brioche Stripe patt, using MC for A and CCI for B. There should be 32 MC knit sts in each column on the RS, and 32 CCI knit sts in each column on the WS. Cut CCI.

Section 2

Join CC2. Work 32 rows in Brioche Stripe patt, using MC for A and CC2 for B.

Rows 33-62: Work in Brioche Stripe patt, using CC2 for A and MC for B.

Rows 63-94: Work in Broche Stripe patt, using MC for A and CC2 for B. Cut CC2.

Section 3

Work as for Section 2, using CC3 in place of CC2.

Section 4

Work as for Section 2, using CC4 in place of CC2.

Section 5

Work as for Section 2, using CC5 in place of CC2, then BO as follows: With MC, k1; *p1, BO 1st st over 2nd st, brk, BO 1st st over 2nd st; rep from * to last 2 sts; p1, BO 1st st over 2nd st, k1, BO 1st st over 2nd st. Cut yarn and fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends; block gently.
